Please encourage parents to fill out the Camper Application form completely. Include all medications, medical conditions and insurance information. Please check each application before sending.

NOTE: Incomplete applications will be charged \$10; please check each application before sending it in.

Prior to coming to Breakaway, ask parents for any changes in medicines and conditions. If there are changes, please fill out the 2009 Kid's Medical Departure Update.

Collect the medications from the children before leaving the church. Check and assure that all medications are in the original, pharmaceutical containers with proper instructions.

PLEASE do not bring a camper without properly packaged medication. If there is a problem, alert parents and have the parent deliver it ASAP. Our medical personnel can only dispense medications from the original, pharmaceutical containers.

Selecting pictures or graphics is an important part of adding content to your newsletter.

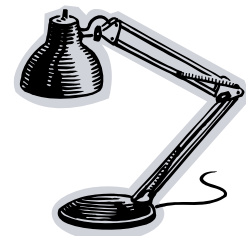
Think about your article and ask yourself if the picture supports or enhances the message you're trying to convey. Avoid selecting images

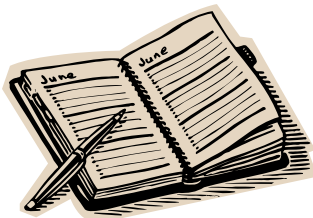

Back Page Story Headline

This story can fit 175-225 words.

If your newsletter is folded and mailed, this story will appear on the back. So, it's a good idea to make it easy to read at a glance.

A question and answer session is a good way to quickly capture the attention of readers. You can

either compile questions that you've received since the last edition or you can summarize some generic questions that are frequently asked about your organization.

A listing of names and titles of managers in your organization is a good way to give your newsletter a personal touch. If your organization is small, you may want to list the names of all employees.

If you have any prices of standard products or services, you can include a listing of those here. You may want to refer your readers to any other forms of communication that you've created for your organization.

You can also use this space to remind readers to mark their calendars for a regular event, such as a breakfast meeting for vendors every third Tuesday of the month, or a biannual charity auction.

If space is available, this is a good place to insert a clip art image or some other graphic.
